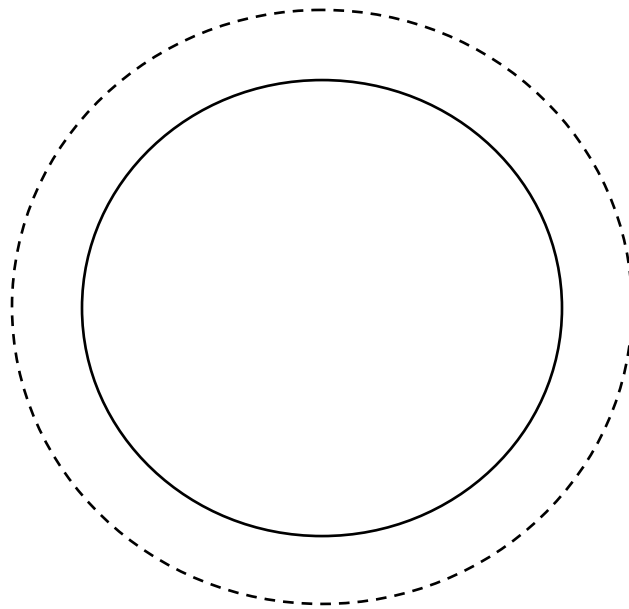
Who is Satan?
